New Way of Doing Things....

Thanks for checking in with our student ministry! Starting today, I want to take this opportunity to share more than just announcements with you. I want share some thoughts with you about youth culture, our student ministry, and how I see God moving in students. The point is you can be better informed on how best to pray for our students and student ministry and you can rejoice with me when we have a victory! To begin, I want to share with you a portion of our student ministry's overarching strategy. An important aspect of our ministry is how students come into our ministry and progress through our ministry. One of the easiest ways to visualize this is to look at our student ministry as a house.

The Porch

For a lot of homes, the porch of a home is the first place someone sees when they come to your house. It's a place that anyone is able to come to and lots of people do come! Salesmen, the mailman, Girl Scouts selling cookies, neighbors, and good friends all come through the porch. For our student ministry, we see our Wednesday night service as our porch. Any youth is welcome to come on Wednesday nights and it is often the first thing they see of our ministry. On Wednesday night, they begin to learn about worship and hear about Christ's offer of salvation. We have a lot of students come and go from this group but some take the next step.

The Living Room

If you have made it into the living room of my home, then chances are you are a friend of mine. The living room for our student ministry is our Sunday Morning Bible Study. This is the place where we believe the majority of teens have already bought into our student ministry and are ready to really learn about the Lord. The teachers help these students draw even closer to the Lord through Bible Study and more mature worship.

The Kitchen

Where is the place to be on Thanksgiving at Grandma's house? If you said anywhere besides the kitchen, you are missing out! The kitchen is the place for family discussions, taste-testing the food, and a lot more! For our student ministry, our servant leadership group and occasional small group Bible Studies are in the kitchen. These are the students who have exhibited leadership potential and great devotion to the Lord. While they will make mistakes, these students are some of the best we have. These students also are taught to view Wednesday night as a missional opportunity; God brings kids to Wednesday night that don't know Christ and these students can share Christ with them.
